## Check In Procedure Changing

The 2009 NLBFR contestant check in at Colorado State Fairgrounds, in Pueblo, will begin by entering the fairgrounds from Mesa Avenue, Gates #3 & #4. Upon reaching the check-in station, you must have all required paperwork for each horse and any other animal you brought onto the facility. All horses will be unloaded and inspected at this time. We thank you in advance for being prepared for the check-in process.

### COLORADO STATE LIVESTOCK REQUIREMENTS AS OF 5-1-09 (SUBJECT TO CHANGE)

**Please check [www.nlbra.com](http://www.nlbra.com) for updates.**

The following paperwork is required for each and every horse arriving on grounds regardless of the state of origin. **Please bring 2 copies of each.** One to keep with you and one for our files.

- 1) Paperwork proof of Valid Coggins.
- 2) State brand inspection papers and/or proof of ownership depending on state.
- 3) Valid health papers are required for ALL animals. (This includes dogs, goats, pigs, llamas, etc.)

**Note:** These requirements also apply to those contestants who will not be stalling during the Finals. All horses must go through the initial check in process AND it will be necessary to have two copies of all paperwork. Thank you for your cooperation.

Ronny helped many children with entry fees in the past 20 years and would be proud to offer these scholarships today. NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED! NO ENTRIES ACCEPTED WITHOUT MONEY!

3. **EVENT FEES:** LISTED BY EVENT ON ENTRY FORM.

4. **SECURITY FEE:** This fee of \$20 is paid ONCE per contestant.

5. **NLBRA MEMBER FEE:** This \$9 is paid ONCE, when you send in your ORIGINAL ENTRY FORM.

6. **STALLS:** \$85 per stall. Please indicate # of stalls needed

- One horse per stall. **First Entered/First RESERVED.** ALL HORSES MUST BE STALLED. STALLS MUST BE CLEANED DAILY – please take your dirty shavings and manure to the collection areas.
- If you are requesting to be stalled next to someone, the best way to ensure that you are stalled together is to send in your entries together.
- Tack stalls available upon request. \$85 per stall. First come first served due to a very limited number of tack stalls available.

7. **HOOK-UP CAMPING SPACES:** \$125 per space measured at 15' w X 40' L. Please indicate # of spaces needed. **More than 1 space is needed if rig is longer than 45'**

- Best value -- Includes electricity (50 amp), water and sewage or 2 pumps during the week from the sewage truck. Additional pumps are your expense.
- If you are requesting to be camped next to someone, the best way to ensure that you are camped together is to send in your entries together.

8. **DRY CAMPING SPACES:** "No Hook-ups" Camping spaces are \$50. Please indicate # of spaces needed.

- **No** generators will be allowed to operate on the grounds.
- If you are requesting to be camped next to someone, the best way to ensure that you are camped together is to send in your entries together.

9. **GOLF CART RENTAL:** This service provides a more convenient way to get around the grounds. Please mark which style of cart you wish to reserve and add the appropriate amount to the entry. GOLF CART: \$325- 2 PASSENGER; \$350 – 4 PASSENGER; \$350 – UTILITY

10. **RODEO PASSES:** \$20 per person. Parents and non-contestants 8 years old and older need a rodeo pass. Good for general admission seating to all 11 NLBFR performances. BIG R of Pueblo is offering this pass for \$10, information can be found at [www.nlbra.com](http://www.nlbra.com) on the NLBFR Finals page and clicking the BIG R link.

11. **ADULT HELPER PASS:** \$35 per person (INCLUDES HAZERS). Adults assisting contestants during the NLBFR must adhere to all rules as stated, including dress code, in the NLBRA Official Rulebook. This includes wearing a back number when in the designated "Arena" area. **Must** order through the NLBRA. (Remakes for lost helper passes will be \$3.00)

11. **QUALIFIER BUCKLE:** \$130 if ordered before June 16, 2009; \$137.50 after.

Contestant's portion of the form **MUST** be completed, then mail direct, along with invoice of services and copy of any Explanation of Benefits from other (Primary) Insurance, to the insurance claims office for payment. The deductible and co-insurance is paid directly to attending physician or hospital by parent(s), guardian(s), or contestant.
19. Contestant and Parents **MUST** sign on both the entry blank and consent form (pages 3 & 5). The consent form (Page 5) **MUST** be witnessed and signed by a notary public to be valid.

The drawing tickets will be offered one (1) for \$5 and five (5) for \$20 donation; however, in the event that an individual "demands" a ticket without making a contribution a ticket must be given regardless of a financial contribution. This is what distinguishes this fundraiser as a drawing.
